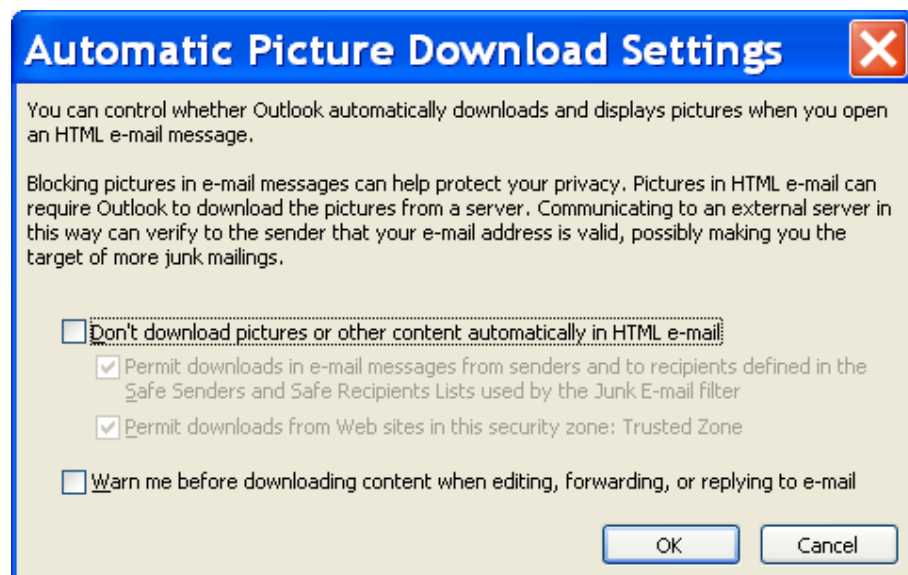
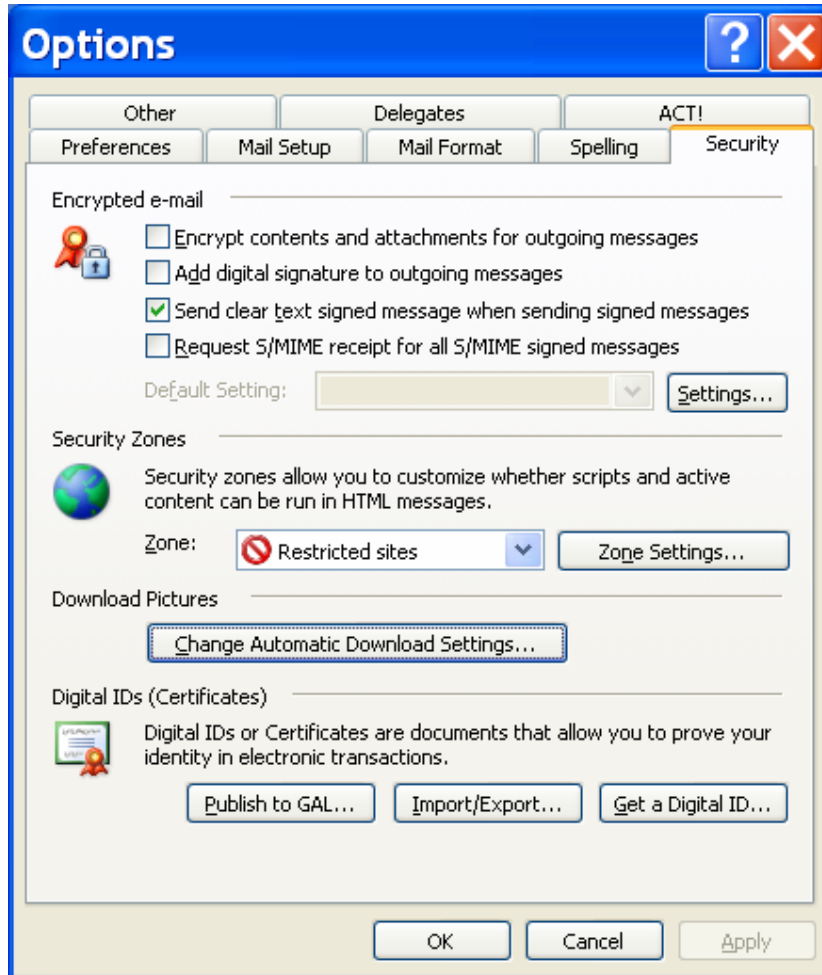


Outlook

- To display images for individual emails:

Right-click on one of the missing images and select **Download Pictures**.

- To disable image blocking:
 1. On the **Tools** menu, click **Options**.
 2. Click **Security**.
 3. Under Download Pictures, click **Change Automatic Download Settings**.
 4. Uncheck Don't download pictures or other content automatically in HTML email.

Images are not displayed. Display images below - Always display images from <email address>.

- To display images for individual senders:

Click "**Always display images from <email address>**" at the top of the email.
This note will appear at the top of the email:
Images are not displayed. Display images below - Always display images from <email address>.

Entourage

- To display images for individual emails:

Click "**Download images**".

- To display images from contacts that are in your address book:

Click **Entourage > Preferences > Security > Automatically download**.
